Infantry Brigades

חטיבות חי״ר

Regular infantry brigades (חי"ר) are open to males only. Infantry brigades do most of the "routine grunt work" of the IDF, composed of operational duty on the different borders around and within Israel, as well as entering war zones to fight in times of war. Each Infantry Brigade contains a forward reconnaissance battalion (הדוד סיור/גדס"ר) as well, to which you can be accepted after passing a gibbush (physical tryout).

Machal Eligibility: Those drafting through Machal can serve in infantry brigades while serving a minimum of 18 months.

In order to serve in their respective reconnaissance battalions, you must sign on full IDF service of 2 years and 8 months.

The Armored Corps. provides tanks to the IDF and serves on all of the borders of Israel, while fighting alongside infantry and commando units during wartime. The Armored Corps. also trains and fields specific organic infantry battalions (07 חי"רמש) which provide fire support and protection for tanks in urban environments.

Machal Eligibility Those drafting through Machal can draft to Shirion for a minimum of 18 months.

Combat Engineering Corps. חיל הנדסה קרבית

Combat engineers serve in a wide range of infantry and mechanized roles. In addition to full infantry training, combat engineers undergo basic combat engineering training in which they learn to operate as well as dismantle a wide range of explosives. Combat engineers also field tactical armored construction machinery, such as the D9 bulldozer, which work alongside standard infantry and commando units.

Mixed Combat Units יחידות מעורבות - חי״ר גבולות

These units, containing males and females, are under the command of the Border Defense Corps. (חיל הגנת הגבולות) and undergo infantry training. They are deployed in the Jordanian, Egyptian, and West Bank areas of operation, where they carry out a variety of missions to protect the state of Israel including anti-smuggling, border patrols, field intelligence gathering, and anti-terror operations. There is also an option for women to draft to "Plugat Perah" which is an all-female tank company that is under the command of the Border Defense Corps.

Machal Eligibility Those drafting through Machal can draft to these units and serve the minimum of 18 months.

This unit undergoes infantry training (05) and specializes in gathering field intelligence. Their work often entails long stakeouts and the use of advanced technological tools such as drones and specialized observation devices to gather information on the enemy. In addition to intelligence gathering, these soldiers learn a high level of camouflage and concealment techniques.

Combat intelligence units also have their own specialized units with internal tryout processes.

This Corps. specializes in Artillery warfare, and additionally operates elite units that utilize classified drones and missiles. Since Artillery is not routinely utilized outside of large scale wars, artillery soldiers also receive basic infantry training (O3) and regularly act as infantry on security missions on the towns, villages, and borders of Israel and Judea and Samaria that are considered "lower risk" but still require a security presence.

Machal Eligibility Those drafting through Machal can serve in the Artillery Corps. for a minimum of 18 months.

Search & Rescue פלח״ץ

This brigade specializes in Search and Rescue missions during emergency times as part of the Homefront Command. These missions include searching for civilians and soldiers under collapsed buildings, identifying dangerous structures for combat units to avoid, Homefront defense during wars, & more. They also go through basic infantry training (07) and in the absence of wars or disasters, the unit performs infantry missions, and assists in demolitions alongside standard infantry and commando units, usually in Judea and Samaria.

Machal Eligibility Those drafting through Machal can serve in the Search & Rescue for a minimum of 18 months.

Checkpoint Security (M. P.) לוחמי מעברים

This unit falls under the Military Police Corps. and is stationed at the different checkpoints located on the borders of the country, most commonly in Judea and Samaria, but also Gaza and Jordan. Soldiers are trained as basic infantrymen (O3) and as military police. They are responsible for interrogating the vehicles & people travelling in and out of these areas for contraband, weapons, or wanted persons.

Machal Eligibility Those drafting through Machal can serve in the M.P. Checkpoints for a minimum of 18 months.

Border Police (Magav) מג״ב

Magav is a paramilitary unit under the Israeli Police, not the IDF. However, new draftees to the IDF are routinely assigned to Magav. Soldiers undergo police training, as well as infantry training (05), with their mission being to prevent terror attacks, assist with policing and routine security in population centers, fight crime, crack down on illegal residency, prevent illegal riots, and more. A high level of Hebrew is a prerequisite for serving in Magav. For those interested Magav also has a robust career path within the unit following mandatory service, unlike most other infantry roles.

The Israeli Air Defense Force protects the country from aerial threats such as rockets, missiles, drones, and enemy aircraft. Air defense batteries are deployed nationwide and operate in coordination with Air Force radar systems. Soldiers from the unit are deployed together with the defense batteries and protect and maintain them.

In the event of an aerial rocket or missile attack on Israel, these soldiers activate the defense systems to protect the country.

The first Ultra-Orthodox (Haredi) Infantry Brigade in the IDF was founded in 2024. Their purpose is to enable Haredi soldier to serve in a framework that aligns with their way of life and preserves their Haredi identity. The brigade is staffed with commanders who define themselves as G-D fearing. The Brigade also has a team of recruiters who can help soldiers with complicated medical or personal backgrounds overcome bureaucratic issues to draft.

Chetz is a religious company within the Paratroopers 202nd Battalion. The company is a regular infantry company like all others, but they also receive food with a higher level of Kosher supervision, less contact with female Combat Support soldiers, and set times to pray and study Torah among other things. The unique quality of Chetz in that it requires a Gibbush for entry; separating it from Netzach and Chashmonaim.


Netzach Yehuda is an infantry battalion that belongs to the Kfir Brigade of the IDF's Infantry Corps. The unit is a regular infantry unit like all others, but they also receive food with a higher level of Kosher supervision, less contact with female Combat Support soldiers, and set times to pray and study Torah, among other religious practices. Previously they served primarily in Judea and Samaria, this is no longer the case.

Machal Eligibility Those drafting through Machal can serve in Netzach Yehuda for a minimum of 18 months.

Interview Week For Various Special Units:

Intelligence, Cyber, Lotar (Counterterrorism), Balnam (Operational drivers), Paratroopers Recon, Givati Recon, Golani Recon, Armored Corps Recon, Nahal Recon, Kfir Recon, Oketz, Yahalom, Moran\Rochash, Refaim, Yamas, 504 (Human Intelligence), and others.

*Keep in mind that if you draft through Machal (without having Israeli Citizenship) you will not be eligible to serve in any unit that requires a government issued Security clearance. Almost all Special Units require a security clearance check.

Counterterror (Lotar) Instructor

This special unit specializes in counterterror warfare instruction. They can be used as combat soldiers, but this occurs rarely. Mostly they focus on training combat units throughout the army in CQB, shooting, and counter terror tactics and techniques.

- Fail out of a more elite units training pipeline

Artillery Corps. Special Units מורן/רוכ״ש

Moran (מורן) and Rochev Shamayim (רוכ״ש) are special units within the Artillery brigade and are open to females and males. רוכב שמיים specializes in operating UAV's while מורן specializes in operating classified and highly accurate missiles. Full service and security clearance required. These units are not open to Machal volunteers.

Acceptance Through:

- · Pass tryout within Artillery
- Interview week (see flowchart p.16)
- Fail out of a more elite units training pipeline

Combat Mobility Unit לוחם ניוד מבצעי (בלנ״מ)

A vehicular combat driving force that uses an assortment of vehicles to evacuate casualties, transport supplies, and move troops in the field. Fighters are trained in professional combat driving and operational mobility. The training includes four months of basic training and eight months of professional instruction (07). Soldiers can advance to command, instructional, or officer roles.

Acceptance Through:

- Asking for an interview from Meitav and passing the interview stage.
- Interview week (see flowchart p.16)
- Need a manual (stick shift) drivers license

Open to both males & females. Soldiers in Oketz do not operate as an organic unit but rather allocate canine handlers to other units who need their specialty. Oketz dogs have a wide variety of specialties including attack dogs, bomb sniffing dogs, tracking dogs, and much much more. Israeli citizenship and security clearance is required to serve here.

Acceptance Through

- Men: Fall from Elite Unit or Gadnat Oketz
- Interview week (see flowchart p.16)
- Females: Pass tryout from within Mixed Infantry



Elite unit of the Combat Engineering Corps. Open to both males & females. Responsible for special engineering missions. The unit works with many different advanced technologies including -but not limited to- robots, drones, high explosives, mines, tunnel warfare, and much more. Women can serve as combat soldiers in Yahalom, but in specific roles.

Israeli citizenship and security clearance is required to serve here.

Acceptance Through

- Pass tryouts within Engineering Corps.
- Fall from Flite Unit
- Interview week (see flowchart p.16)

Elite combat unit within The Intelligence Corps. Open to both males & females. Unit 504 performs clandestine and covert operations, gathers military intelligence, and performs special operations outside the borders of Israel.

Not much more can be said about this unit, due to security constraints.

Elite counter terror unit within the Border Police, often placed under IDF command. Emphasis on urban warfare, CQB, marksmanship, hostage rescue, working undercover in enemy territory, and more. Yamas often works in the West Bank, and specializes in undercover missions and high value target arrests. They also have high level SWAT training, however their training does not focus on large scale war fighting.

Acceptance Through

- Pass a tryout inside of Magav

Elite multi-domain combat unit, founded to lead future battlefield innovations. Also known as the "Ghost" unit or the "Multi-dimensional" unit (יחידה הרב מימדי). Operates in all terrains and fronts, specializing in locating and eliminating threats and developing new battlefield technologies and techniques.

- Yachatiot tryout (tryout within infantry units)
- Fall from an elite unit
- Interview week (see flowchart p.16)

Urban warfare specialists, undercover missions and arrests in the West Bank and Gaza

Egoz



Specializes in guerilla warfare behind enemy lines, especially in heavy brush and forrests.

Maglan



Specializes in missile warfare, intelligence gathering, and deep strike missions.

The Commando Brigade is the tip of the spear of the IDF. They recieve the most difficult and dangerous conventional missions, and are also frequently called upon for unconventional missions.

Israeli citizenship and security clearance is required to serve here.

- Yachatiot tryout (tryout within infantry units)

Tier One Elite Units 1 יחידות עילית דרגה









The above units are considered the elite of the elite of the IDF. Service in these units requires Israeli citizenship – it is often difficult for Olim Chadashim to reach these units as they are not always able to pass the security clearance and intensive screening that's required before and during training. A high level of Hebrew language, teamwork ability, and social skills are required to finish training in these elite units.

Navy חיל הים

The Israeli Navy is the maritime branch of the Israel Defense Forces (IDF), responsible for protecting Israel's coastline, territorial waters, and maritime trade routes. It conducts defense, intelligence, and special operations—both above and below the sea—to prevent threats and ensure national security. Despite its small size, the Navy is highly advanced and works closely with other IDF branches to safeguard Israel's interests at sea.

Acceptance through

Completing a 2 day tryout. Once accepted into the navy, you can request any of the units listed and go through a series of interviews to get in.

Missile Boat Sailor לוחם סטי"ל

Missile Boat Sailors serve as part of a tightknit, professional crew operating advanced missile ships at sea. Their mission combines combat, navigation, and the operation of cutting-edge weapon, radar, and defense systems while executing complex and classified missions in Israel's maritime arena.

They provide Israel with a powerful and precise strike capability, protecting strategic maritime assets, trade routes, and national sovereignty. Service aboard these ships demands teamwork, discipline, and technical excellence under challenging conditions.



יחידת סנפיר

The Snapir Unit is a unique naval security force responsible for protecting Israel's ports and nearby maritime areas. Its fighters prevent hostile infiltrations, underwater and surface attacks, and secure both military and civilian vessels in the ports of Haifa, Ashdod, and Eilat.

Operating in small teams aboard fast, agile boats called Tzar'a, Snapir soldiers react instantly to threats and perform both routine and emergency missions. Training includes navigation, diving, vessel operation, maritime shooting, and close cooperation with other security forces.

Underwater Missions Unit ילת"ם

The sailors of the Underwater Missions Unit (YALTAM) specialize in diving and carrying out special underwater operations in deep-sea environments. Their missions include underwater demolition, installing and testing maritime systems, and performing complex technical tasks in challenging conditions.

They also conduct rescue and recovery dives, joint exercises with foreign navies, and operate advanced underwater technologies in cooperation with other Navy units.

Naval Security Flotillas פלגות הבט"ש

These combat sailors serve on Navy patrol ships, carrying out key and often classified missions to defend Israel's maritime borders. They operate advanced combat systems, navigate vessels, and work closely with air and ground forces to prevent threats at sea.

Training is intense, both physically and mentally, focusing on weapon operation, navigation, and teamwork under pressure.

Submarine Fighters שייטת הצוללות

The Submarine Flotilla is an elite, highly classified unit of the Israeli Navy. Its submarines serve as a strategic and deterrent force, capable of carrying out covert missions deep in enemy territory and across the globe. These operations ensure Israel's security and strategic advantage at sea.

Submarine Fighters operate advanced systems under extreme pressure and in complete secrecy. The role demands resilience, precision, technical expertise, and teamwork in confined and challenging environments.

Those with foreign non-Israeli citizenships will need to renounce their foreign citizenship(s) to serve in this unit because of the sensitive nature of their work.

Those drafting through Machal cannot serve in this unit.

Ship Captain

Naval Ship Commanders course. In 3 years of training you learn to be the captain of a naval vessel. After finishing training, you are required to serve an additional 4 years. They have their own tryout that can be reached through Yom Sayeorot. An extremely high level of Hebrew is needed, often even Israelis can not pass their Hebrew exam.

Combat Communications Officer (Kashrag) קשר"ג

The Combat Communications Officer (Kashrag) is a combat officer specializing in operating and managing advanced electronics and communication software and hardware systems on the battlefield. The role combines leadership, technology, and field operations. Soldiers draft to the course, finish as officers, and then are assigned to a combat unit to serve with in.

Operational Intelligence Officer (Kaman)

The Battalion Intelligence Officer is responsible for managing the intelligence operations within a combat battalion. This unique role combines leadership, technology, and combat, directly influencing the unit's operational activity during routine missions, field deployments, and wartime operations.

Combat Paramedic פרמדיק

Combat Paramedics are trained to provide advanced emergency medical care in the field — on the front lines, in special units, and during operational missions. They operate in high-pressure environments, saving lives and supporting combat troops during routine and emergency situations alike. It is a difficult role to be accepted to. Those accepted go through a year and a half course prior to their draft, are trained as basic infantry (O3) and are then assigned to a combat unit.

Tzameret Program – Combat Doctor רופא קרבי - מסלול צמרת

The Tzameret Program trains future IDF Doctors who serve as combat physicians in combat units (including the possibility of serving in elite units), combining medicine, leadership, and command.

Participants study medicine in Israeli universities with a focus on military and trauma care, emergency medicine, and occupational health, alongside enrichment in leadership, management, and Israeli history. The program offers full tuition, housing, and living expenses throughout the degree.

Graduates earn an M.D., with the option of completing a PhD during their education, and join the IDF as Battalion Medical Officers. These doctors lead medical teams in the field and on base and provide critical care under combat and non-combat conditions.

After they finish their time in the IDF, they can begin their career as a Doctor in Israel.

"Erez" Program – Elite Officer Leadership Track

The Erez Program develops the IDF's future infantry and Special Forces combat officers and leaders. It combines commando level training, officer qualification, and a dual-major academic degree at Tel Aviv University.

Graduates earn the rank of Lieutenant (סגן) and serve as combat commanders across all ground forces.

The selection process is among the most elite in the IDF, pulling the most qualified participants from Yom Sayarot, special forces tryouts, and further academic screening.

Program commitment: 4 years of permanent service after training.

Designed for exceptional, motivated candidates with strong leadership and resilience



Pilots Course is one of the most prestigious courses and jobs the IDF offers. After finishing the course of three years, you receive a Bachelors Degree, and are assigned a plane or helicopter type with which to train and carry out missions inside Israel and around the world. Very few are accepted to training, and even fewer finish. Alongside Chovlim, likely the most difficult role for an immigrant to be accepted to and complete.
